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Questions and Answers:

Question 1: Is SDSWCD aware of any additional permitting or licensing required for the execution of the project outside of standard state of alaska business and contractor licensing?

Answer: No

Question 2: Does the contractor incur cost for SDSWCD HAZMAT training?

Answer: The contractor is responsible for their own Hazardous Material Safety Plan (HMCP) and meeting the requirements of the RFP. The Eielson required HAZ-WASTE training is offered to the contractor by Eielson Environmental free of charge.

Question 3: What is the approximate distance from the current location of the material pile to the new storage location?

Answer: The requirement in the RFP is to bail the material and place it on the beach (See Attachment B in the RFP).

Question 4: How is the material to be placed or re-piled at the new location?

Answer: Material is to be stockpiled at the designated location adjacent to the pond (See Attachment B in the RFP).
