Depending on funding, there is a potential for increased quantity of similar materials (other rock products) to be awarded under this contract; increases will be awarded at our discretion and without re-bidding.

Summary of RFQ

This quote is for riffle rock (similar to Class II riprap), that meets the specifications below:

Riffle Rock Material Specifications:

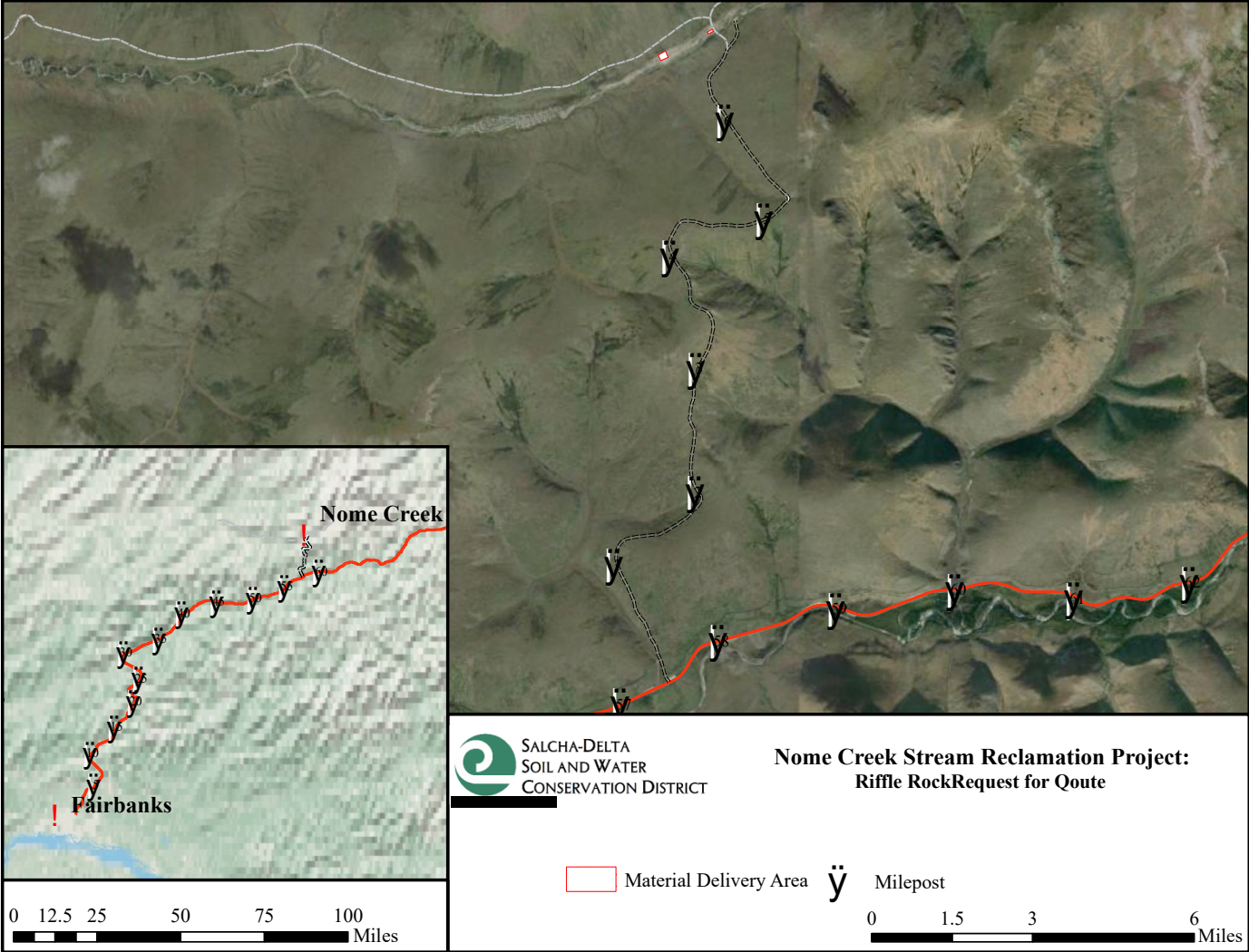
- 50 – 60 % weighing 200 pounds or more
- 15 % weighing up to 25 pounds
- 25 % weighing 25 – 200 pounds
- 10 % weighing more than 400 pounds
- All evenly graded angular stones.

Quote Parameters:

- 1) 3,000 CY of Riffle Rock (the material reference above).
- 2) Loading and delivery to the jobsite (including pushing material up into stockpiles) near the US Creek Road bridge over Nome Creek (map below).
 - a. First portion (1,000 to 1,500 CY) delivered NLT 09 June 2024 (fall delivery is preferred to allow early start next season).
 - b. Second portion (remainder of 3,000 CY) delivered NLT 28 June 2024 (delivery of all material in the fall or prior to 09 June 2024 is acceptable).

Payment

Payment will occur in two phases if necessary. Payment for the first portion and second portions of the rock will occur upon delivery.
